The Turkish Parliament adopted on 3 August 2002 a comprehensive package of amendments to various laws with a view to fulfilling the Copenhagen political criteria in the run up to the EU Copenhagen Summit. I enclose herewith the highlights of this package.

These new steps ensure harmonization with the earlier amendments made in the Turkish Constitution and the Turkish Civil Code and amend various laws in line with the Turkish National Program with due regard to the priorities listed in the Accession Partnership document under political criteria.

The ongoing reform process in Turkey attest to the determination of our people to join the EU as part of the current enlargement process.

The difficult decisions entailed by the latest reforms reflect the confidence of our people in the sincerity of the EU in embracing Turkey as a candidate State destined to join the EU on the basis of the same criteria as applied to the other candidate States.
