Biographical facts: Born in Agrigento, on the 25th February 1947, residing in Palermo. Married, with three children. Professor of Public Accountancy at the Faculty of law of the University of Palermo. He has been Professor of Constitutional Law in the same faculty and Professor in charge of Administrative law at the Faculty of business economics at the University of Palermo. Winner of prizes and scholarships in Italy and abroad. Lawyer of the Supreme Court and official Auditor.

He has been Councillor of Palermo Municipality for Culture, Estate, City Police and President of the Budget Committee and of the Statute Committee.

Elected to the Senate for the first time, for Forza Italia, in the Constituency Palermo-Capaci, in the 1994. Re-elected, in the same constituency, in the 1996 and in the 2001.

Designated President of the Forza Italia parliamentary group at the Senate, on the 14th, June 1994, and reconfirmated of the appointment on the 10th, May 1996.

Member of the Council of Europe-UEO during the 12th Legislature, of the Committee for the Constitutional Affairs during the 12th and the 13th Legislature, and of the Committee Finance and Treasury during the 13th Legislature.
